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#### Abstract

#### Introduction

Mirziyoyev, ideological and legal foundations are being created in the politics of Uzbekistan related to entering the world market and adapting to the new requirements of development. In order to consistently continue the wide-ranging reforms implemented in the country, an "action strategy" on five priority areas of development of the Republic of Uzbekistan in 2017-2021 was approved [1]. In this regard, the state program of work to be carried out in 2020 called "development of science, enlightenment and digital economy" was also approved.

The President of the Republic of Uzbekistan, Shavkat Mirziyoev, in his address to the Senate and the Legislative Chamber of the Oliy Majlis on January 24, 2020, states that "as we aim to make Uzbekistan a developed country, we can achieve this only through rapid reforms, science and innovation". The head of our state determines the priority tasks of development based on the fact that every country and nation is powerful with its intellectual potential and high spirituality. It is worth noting that the priority tasks are considered the most important and necessary conditions of the international document aimed at improving the economic, social and ecological situation on our planet, and increasing the well-being of people - "UN Sustainable Development Goals". This document, approved at the UN summit, consists of 17 sets of goals and



169 tasks, including tasks in the field of increasing education, intellectual potential, and increasing the attention of states to human capital. The resolution "On strengthening the role of parliaments in accelerating the achievement of sustainable development goals" was adopted by the UN General Assembly. It ensures that the strategies, concepts and programs that determine the development of the countries are able to serve the implementation of the national sustainable development goals. Based on the in-depth analysis of complex global processes and the results of our country's development, in the following years, on the basis of the principle of "For the dignity of man", the priority directions of reforms aimed at further increasing the wellbeing of our people and the formation of an active civil society, as a result of a broad public discussion, were adopted as a result of the "Strategy of Actions - Strategy of Development" "Development Strategy of New Uzbekistan for 2022 - 2026" consisting of seven priority directions developed based on the principle of "toward" was approved. "On January 26, 2022, a meeting of video selectors was held to determine the development strategy for 2022-2026 and to discuss its implementation this year. At the meeting, President Sh. Mirziyoev explained the essence of the development strategy of New Uzbekistan, the mechanisms of its implementation in the near and medium term.

The President of Uzbekistan Sh.Mirziyoev has defined a specific national program of implementation of the UN Sustainable Development Goals, which Uzbekistan has undertaken to implement in the Action Strategy and the Development Strategy. "Development Strategy for 2022-2026" accelerated the pace of social life and led to the adoption of the "New Constitution" in Uzbekistan. This newly adopted law, which is recognized as the "Constitution of the Social State", became the legal basis for the qualitative renewal of the development of the society. As a result, on September 12, 2023, the "Uzbekistan-2030" strategy of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Sh.Mirziyoev No. PF-158, consisting of 5 priority directions and 100 goals, was adopted.[2] This is a clear indication that development in New Uzbekistan is undergoing a qualitative renewal. In addition, a system for the implementation of the "Uzbekistan-2030" strategy for the implementation of national goals and tasks in the field of sustainable development in the period until 2030 in accordance with the "Sustainable Development Goals" of the United Nations was established. At the same time, the process of creating the necessary conditions for achieving the UN Sustainable Development Goals requires the active participation of not only the executive power, but also parliament, civil society institutions, and business entities. Parliament plays an important role in ensuring stable relations between the state and the citizens. Effective use of oversight functions of parliamentary committees is an



important means of achieving the Sustainable Development Goals. This tool allows parliamentarians to objectively assess changes in the process of implementing legislation and achieving the Sustainable Development Goals. Currently, our parliament has sufficient powers and opportunities to ensure the achievement of the national goals of sustainable development. In other words, Uzbekistan, as an equal member of foreign international relations, was able to show the whole world its development in harmony with the UN Sustainable Development Goals, its unique role and importance in this regard, and its exemplary experience. In turn, the development strategy of New Uzbekistan indicates that this important progressive process continues continuously.

Uzbekistan's achievement of the national goals of sustainable development for the period up to 2030 demonstrates the principles of sustainable development of our society and state [3].

After all, this is a guarantee of increasing the competitiveness of our country and national economy. This is a decisive factor for the strengthening of the strength and potential of Uzbekistan, the further prosperity of our country and the well-being of our people.

Today, the draft Convention on the Right to Development is being developed by the international community. In addition, the "Declaration on the Right to Development" has been in force for 35 years. In this sense, the development strategy presented by the President of Uzbekistan fully corresponds to the development trends of the international community and the development trends of the whole world.

In the 2023 BRM (SDG index) rating published by the UN Sustainable Development Solutions Network and international experts, Uzbekistan took 69th place among 166 countries with an index of 71.1. This makes the issue of further acceleration of development urgent for New Uzbekistan. That's why we decided to explain development, its impact on the life of a person, state and society, as well as the development reforms being carried out in New Uzbekistan.
